

The PAC chairman, Neil Dorsey, called the Principal's Advisory Council meeting held on March 27th to order. There was no old business to be discussed and the floor was turned over to Mr. Ferrera. Mr. Ferrera discussed the Flex Schedule FAQ document and requested feedback from the PAC. Some concerns that were addressed were as follows:

- Activity buses will not be effected by the new flex schedule and will continue to operate
- Students attending Governor's School will still have the opportunity to attend pep rallies as flex will be moved to the end of the day on spirit days.
- The PAC discussed options of having some classes and their respective flex back-to-back and PAC favored the schedules as it was previously released.

Mr. Ferrera then updated the PAC that an email was sent to the Battlefield community regarding the sub shortage. Additionally, he shared with the PAC that the librarians are putting together activities for bring your child to work day to be held on April 27th.

Next, Mr. Grazier reviewed the AP testing calendar with the PAC and explained that this year the auditorium will be utilized for testing. He explained that in the past we have not used this location because the desks were too small to comply with the AP testing regulations. However, this year, the school has purchased desks that hook to the seat in front providing students with a more comfortable testing environment with more writing space. Students will pre-bubble their forms so that testing can start in a timely manner on testing days. The PAC requested that the administration team consider an opt in/opt out policy for AP exams next year. Upon conclusion of the AP testing discussion, Mr. Huddle discussed the SOL testing schedule sharing that it is a schedule that is done at Patriot High School and Osborn Park High School and receives high reviews from administration, staff and students.

The last 20 minutes of the meeting were opened up to the PAC as a question and answer session for Mr. Ferrera. A suggestion was made to send the letter that is sent to senior parents regarding the timeline for the graduation date selection to junior parents so they are prepared and potentially post it on the school website so it is accessible to all. Concerns regarding the traffic flow were raised. Mr. Ferrera explained that a traffic study was completed last year and suggestions were implemented.
