

The Principal's Advisory Council meeting held on November 28th began with an introduction of the student representatives from each class. As a discussion of old business, the by-laws were adopted and the Chairman, Mr. Dorsey stated that they would be published. In the highlights portion of the meeting, Mr. Ferrera told the council that the Bobcat Café presentation was postponed until the January meeting but did note that Battlefield High School would host a blood drive on Friday December 16th. Mr. Dorsey added that students interested in receiving information regarding honor cords that are available for blood donations should contact Mrs. Fairbanks in the clinic for the requirements. Next, the council discussed new business which included an update from Mr. Gather on the PWCS infrastructure taskforce, choosing a member to represent Battlefield at the Superintendent Advisory Council on Instruction, a presentation about the proposed change to a flex schedule for the 2017-2018 school year, and a review and root cause analysis of some of the data that was collected through the school survey last year. The PAC will not meet in December but will reconvene in January.
