

BHS Principal's Advisory Council (PAC)

Tuesday September 15, 2020 7pm Minutes

1. Meeting was called to order by Wendi Gruninger, PAC Chairperson. First order of business was to review presented changes to the PAC Bylaws. All proposed changes were accepted, no one opposed. Changes will be made officially, and revised bylaws will be posted on the PAC page.
 - Changes include: Revised on September 2020
 - Article II wording change to continuous improvement plan
 - Article III Flexibility in the composition of PAC membership so long as there is sufficient representation from all stakeholders
 - Article V Monthly Meetings to allow flexibility in date of meeting each month
2. Mary Beth Starkey provided updates on testing.
 - October 14 10th graders will take PSAT
 - October 29 11th graders will take PSAT
