Discussion Topics:

1. Gifted Services at Battlefield - Ms. Burke presented an overview of current and future plans for gifted education. Currently, the GEMS course is offered to seniors. Freshmen and sophomores receive services through English and Science classes. Other options include seminars and independent study. Moving forward, Battlefield will offer the same options, but hopes to utilize a Flex Period during which students could participate in seminars vs. being pulled out of classes. Seminars will focus on various subjects. They can also be accessed on Canvas. Mr. Ferrera is looking forward to a true gifted department at Battlefield.

2. Strategic Plan Overview - Mr. Ferrera tasked the membership with reviewing the PWCS Strategic Plan that incorporates a Flex Period will allow Battlefield to meet the goals of the plan. Battlefield had successfully implemented the Flex Period prior to the pandemic. The faculty committee has voted to re-incorporate. Mr. Ferrera asked for continued input. The schedule would be as follows: Even Days - 2, Flex, 4, 6 Odd Days - 1, 3, 5, 7

3. Traffic Update - The traffic flow in the morning and afternoon continues to be an issue. Mr. Ferrera has requested a new traffic study. The current flow is based on a study conducted in 2007. The school has no jurisdiction over Graduation Drive.

4. Superintendent's Advisory Council of Instruction Update - Mrs. Gruninger summarized SACI's February and March meetings.
